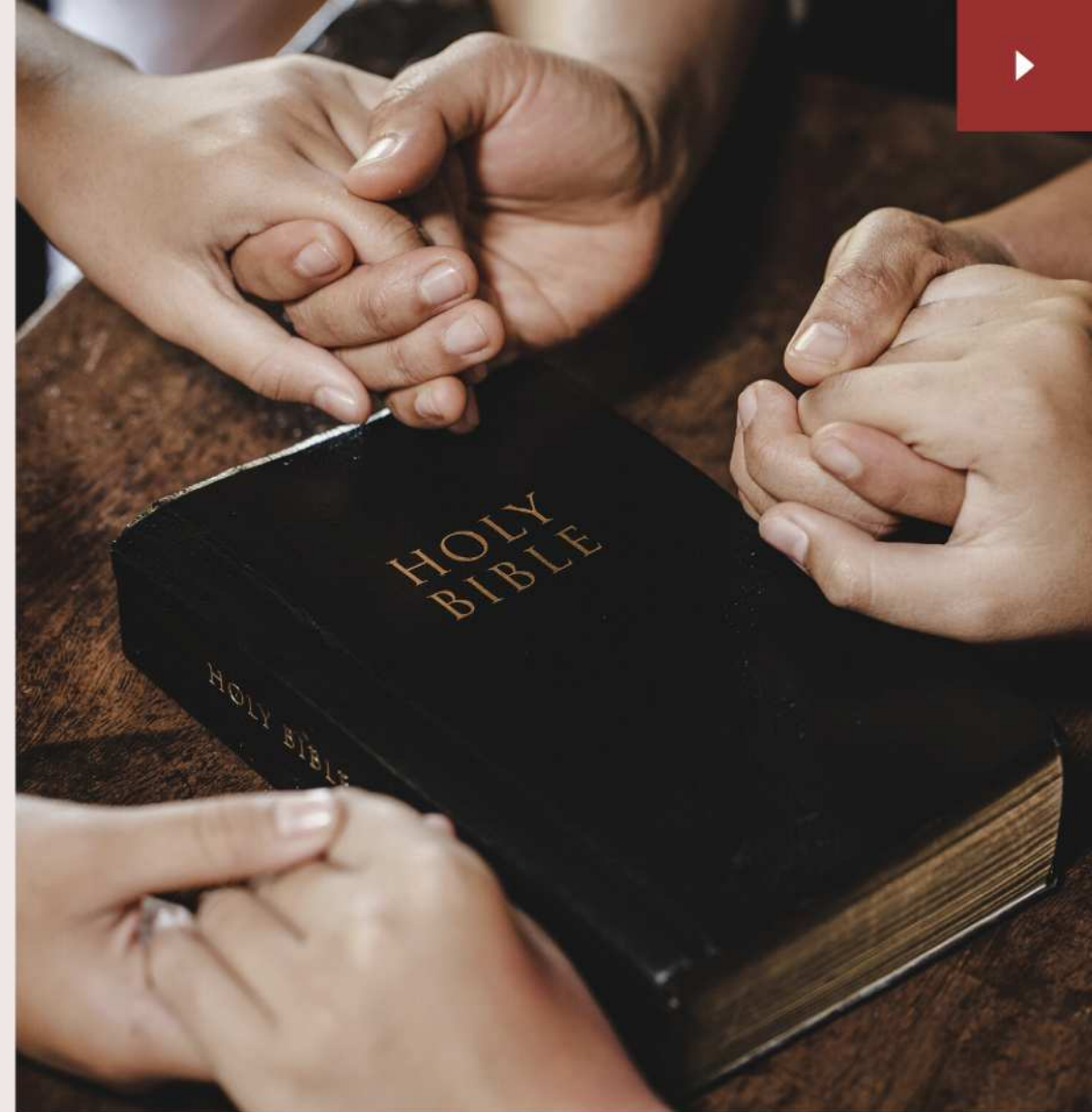

Can you think of a concrete way to demonstrate repentance and contrition as a Filipino citizen?
