

TAKE-HOME PRINCIPLE










10 Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. 11 Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. 12 For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms.


13 Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand. 14 Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, 15 and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace.

In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. 17 Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.

18 And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the Lord's people.

Discovery Question

#2

What armor of God must we have to stand our ground against the spiritual forces of evil?

Paul enumerated the pieces of the armor in the order in which a Roman soldier during his time would normally put them on. And every piece of the armor has a specific use. What do you think is the significance of this as we engage in a spiritual battle?





Understanding Question

#2

If Christ has already won the battle against Satan (Col. 2: 15), why do we still need to put on the armor of God and stand firm?



Understanding Question

#3

Paul's instruction ends with a call to pray (v.18). Why is prayer crucial in our daily battle with the enemy?



Application Question

#1

Share with the group how you/your family can grow stronger in the Lord. What training (example: spending more time studying the Word of the Lord) will you need so that you can stand firmly against the attack of the enemy?



Application Question

#2

Are there any battles that you or your family is currently facing that have been leaving you feeling weak and worn out? Which piece from the armor of God do you think you need to put on to help you "stand your ground?"?

#3

How is your/your family's prayer time? What steps will you take to grow in your prayer life after learning about its importance in our spiritual battle.
