

## Ephesians 4: 15-16

#### NIV

15 Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will grow to become in every respect the mature body of him who is the head, that is, Ćhrist. 16 From him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work.

#### **Application Question** #1.1

#### EPHESIANS 4: 15-16 **Application Question** #1.2

How can you apply "to speak the truth in love" in our modern context? (For example, in the age of relativism (post-modernist "my-truth-your-truth" mentality where, for them, truth is not absolute); cancel culture, and the intolerance of the new "tolerance" mindset (calls out, stigmatizes Christian beliefs as narrow-minded/passé when it touches on certain issues like homosexuality/same-sex marriage and other immoral behavior).



## **Application Question** #2

As part of the body of Christ, how can you build up other members so they will be more like Christ? Share practical ways you can grow your relationship/connectedness with fellow believers/churchmates/CG members/ministry partners.



## **Application Question** #3

Reflect on your growth as a member of the body of Christ. What factors lead you to grow more or less? What steps will you take to deepen further your growth as a member of the body of Christ?


