






## I Timothy 2:1-7 New International Version (NIV)

Instructions on Worship

I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people – 2 for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. 3 This is good, and pleases God our Savior, 4 who wants all people to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth.




## 1 Timothy 2:1-7 New International Version (NIV)

5 For there is one God and one mediator between God and mankind, the man Christ Jesus, 6 who gave himself as a ransom for all people. This has now been witnessed to at the proper time. 7 And for this purpose I was appointed a herald and an apostle-I am telling the truth, I am not lying—and a true and faithful teacher of the Gentiles.




What instruction did Paul give in v. 1-2 and why did Paul specifically mention to pray for those in authority?




Why do we need to pray for all men? What is the goal (v.3)?

How does the Bible view heads of governments and those in authority and what should be our attitude towards them, as believers?


