Instructions for Christian Households

- 18 Wives, submit yourselves to your husbands, as is fitting in the Lord.
- 19 Husbands, love your wives and do not be harsh with them.
- 20 Children, obey your parents in everything, for this pleases the Lord.
- 21 Fathers, do not embitter your children, or they will become discouraged.
