

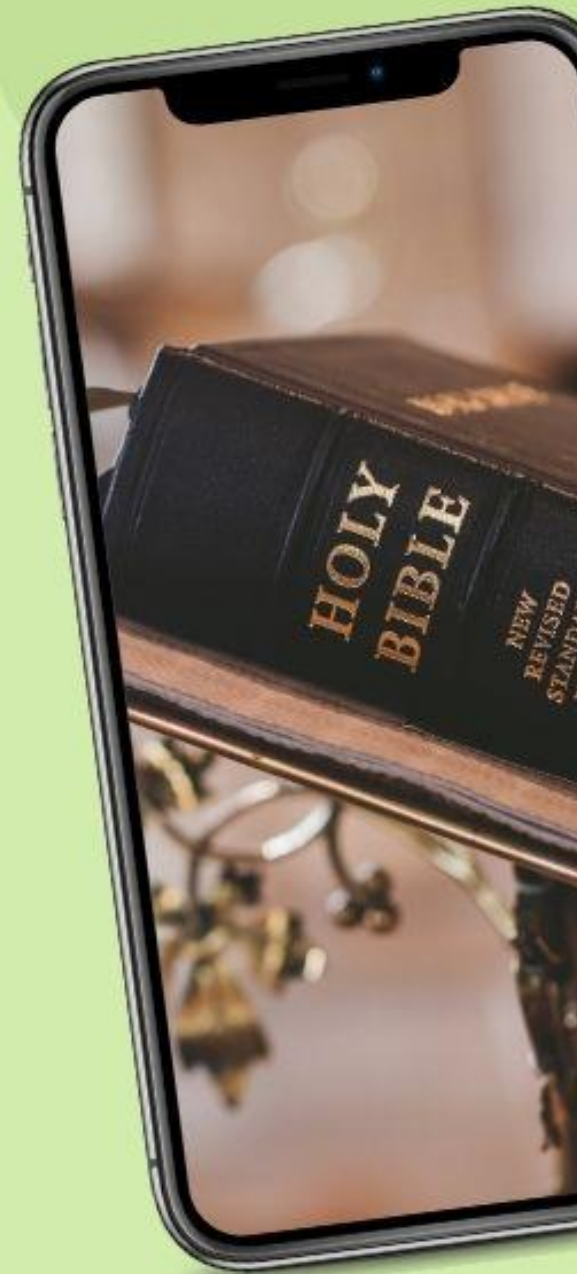

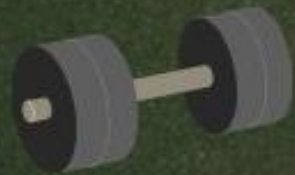

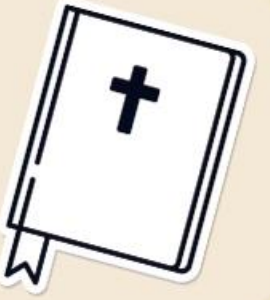

In vv.102-103, the Psalmist expresses that he refrains from evil and hates falsehood. How does a deep understanding of God's Word influence our discernment between right and wrong?

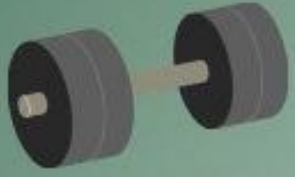


Understanding 4

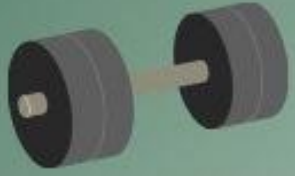

How do you cultivate a deep love and reverence for God's word? Do you consciously and regularly spend time with him? What does meditating on God's word mean to you?

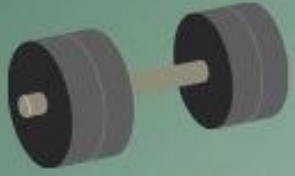


Application 2

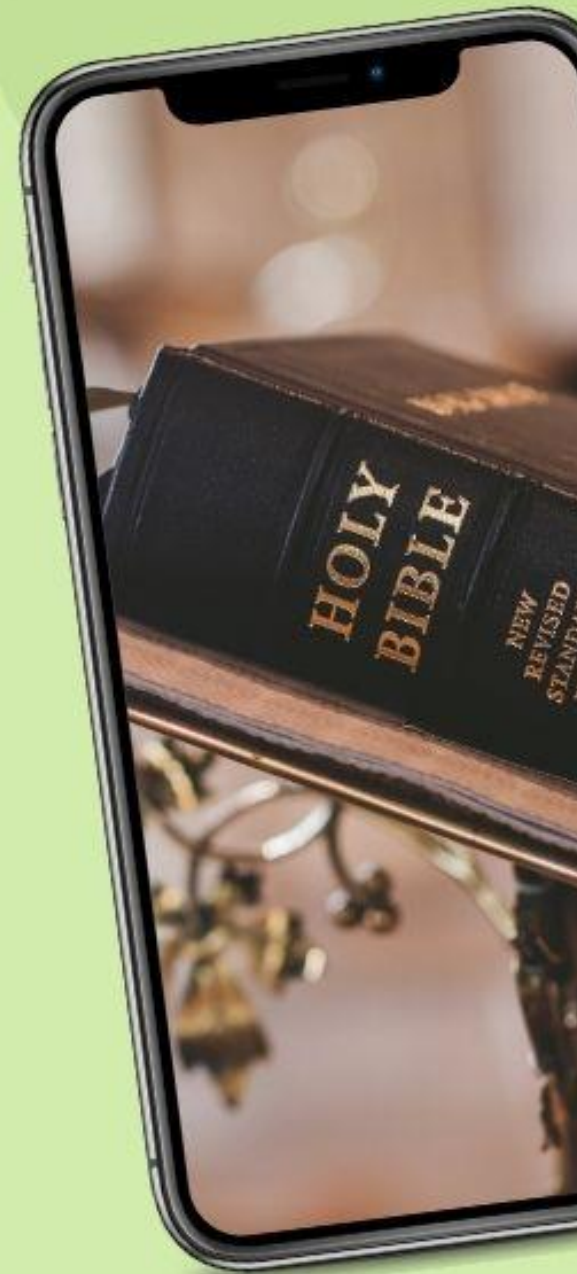
